- f. Master's degree diploma, issued by an officially recognized institution, or an equivalent document proving that the candidate has completed the master's program;
- g. Master's academic transcript;
- h. Undergraduate diploma;
- i. Undergraduate academic transcript.

The program is not responsible for monitoring the processing of the documents. Applications received after the stipulated date will not be approved.

1.5 Approval of application:

The approval of applications will be announced by means of a notice posted at the PCF office and published on the PCF website at www.pcf.uem.br.

1.5.1 The approval of the application is conditional upon the submission of all documents requested in item 1.3.

2 – DEFENSE OF THE PROJECT

2.1 Date of project presentation:

The selection process will be held according to the schedule established by the examining committee, within the period stipulated in item 1.1 of this call.

2.2 Location: Block K-68, Room 213.

2.3 Stages of the selection process:

- a) Oral presentation, from 10 to 15 minutes, of the thesis project before the Selection Committee, followed by questioning. The oral presentation of the project is not open to the public.
- b) Candidate interview.
- c) Curriculum analysis.

3 – RESULTS

3.1 The publication of the results is the responsibility of the PCF Coordination, by means of a notice to be posted at the PCF office and published on the PCF webpage.

4 – ENROLLMENT

4.1 The enrollment period for the students selected through this call will be announced later on the program website.

4.2 Place of enrollment:

4.4 Scholarship:

- Admission of the graduate student to the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences does not imply a commitment to grant a scholarship.

- Calls for the selection of candidates for scholarships will be published when scholarships become available to be allocated to new students, taking into consideration criteria related to academic merit and in accordance with the specific regulations of the stricto sensu graduate program in Brazil, applied by funding agencies such as CAPES, CNPq, or others to which such scholarships are linked at the time of implementation.
- The call for the selection of scholarship recipients will be made available if there is any scholarship availability during the annual validity period of the agencies, after confirmation by the funding agencies regarding the number and type of scholarships.

4.5 Ethical aspects:

Projects involving human beings, animals, or genetically modified organisms must be submitted for analysis and specific approval by the relevant bodies before being initiated.

5 – GENERAL PROVISIONS

5.1 The application fee will not be refunded.

5.2 Submission of documents after the application period will not be permitted.

5.3 The selection process will be valid until the next selection process.

5.4 No documents related to the stages of the selection process will be issued.

5.7 The final result of the selection process will be approved by the Academic Council of the Graduate Program in Pharmaceutical Sciences at the first meeting to be held after the selection process.

5.8 Cases not covered by this call will be resolved by the Coordination of the Graduate Program.
